### **1. DiabloGolf.com**

Please make sure and become a member at Diablogolf.com They will be a co-web host of the Cup and have some really great ways to track the Cup in terms of standing and points. Make sure you type in 'Cascade' as your promo code and you will receive a free sleeve of Callaway Balls for joining. Membership is free and only takes a couple of minutes. Once you do PLEASE request to join the events you are playing in. They are on the home page.

### **2. Caddie requests needed by April 23rd!**

Remember, Chambers is a walking course. If you would like a caddie they are \$50 per caddie/bag. You may share a caddie with your partner but you may not bring your own. Please let me know by the 23rd if you would like one.

### **3. Sandbagging**

**Sandbagging is absolutely unacceptable!** We can't emphasize this enough. The Cascade Golfer Cup is designed to be fair to golfers of all levels and relies on the handicap system to do so. We reserve the right to disqualify anyone or adjust any player/teams handicap that we feel has manipulated their handicap in anyway. Keeping the integrity of the scoring in place is very important for the 2010 Cascade Golfer Cup and future years. **Don't sandbag!**

### **4. Rules**

Q: What is the difference between a bunker and a waste area?

A: Bunkers have rakes and waste areas do not. Stones are removable objects in bunkers only.

Q: On Hole 16 & 17 what do you do if you hit the fence or OB?

A: Re-tee

Also, please note that we are going to be playing with a full field which will cause a slower pace of play. Be patient and have fun!
