1. GHIN/Oki Updates

The next handicap update is going to be on June 1st. That is the ONLY update prior to the next tournament. Please make sure you have paid your dues prior to the 1st (Tuesday) since we require a current and active handicap.

2. Handicapping for the Scramble

The format for this tournament is a two-person net scramble. For this format handicaps will be adjusted as follows, based on the course handicap, to come up with a team handicap:

Take 35% of the lowest handicapped player and 15% of the highest handicap player and add them together to get the teams handicap.

For example, Tom has a handicap of 10 and Jerry has a handicap of 15. You would take 35% of Tom's handicap (3.5) and 15% of Jerry's handicap (2.25) and add them together for their team handicap of 5.75.

Also, please note that each team will need to use 6 tee shots from each player.

3. Hotel Specials

If you are planning on spending Friday and/or Saturday night on the Peninsula we do have a Host Hotel that has extended special rates to players. The Silverdale Beach Hotel is about 20 minutes from the course and is offering a special rate of \$105 for single or double occupancy rooms (normally \$129). Included with the room is a complimentary hot breakfast.

4. Check-In Information

The tournament will begin at 2:00 and check in will begin at Noon. Check-in will be located right in front of the clubhouse. Once you have checked in feel free to use the range, grab lunch at the clubhouse or grab a complimentary beer right next to the check-in table.
